Lastreopsis marginans



Lastreopsis marginans: Glossy Shield

Family: Dryopteridaceae

Genus: Lastreopsis from the Greek opsis (resembling) and the superseded fern genus Lastrea.

Species: *marginans* from the Latin *marginare* (to enclose, to border, to fix on the edge), in reference to the marginal position of the spore.

This is a very glossy dark green, terrestrial fern that spreads locally and grows to a height of 30-60 cms.

It is found in darker areas of rainforest up to high altitudes.
