Lastreopsis microsora: Creeping Shield Fern

Family: Dryopteridaceae

Genus: Lastreopsis from the Greek opsis (resembling) and the superseded fern genus Lastrea.

Species: *microsora* from the Greek *micro* (small), *sorus* in reference to the sori.

This terrestrial fern spreads widely. It has soft, bright green, hairy fronds and grows from 30-100cm. in height.

It is found in rainforests and eucalypt forests, near creeks and on the gently-sloping sides of gullies.
